4b. CONSELLING and TREATMENT Protocols...



Only infants needing <u>INTENSIVE SUPPORT</u> or existing cases showing signs of deterioration should be <u>REFERRED</u> for follow up in the MAMI clinic.

Signs of deterioration include:

- a visible deterioration in the physique of the infant
- clinical signs of deterioration noted by parents/carers

Note: Infants receiving BMS will need to attend MAMI clinics to receive re-supply on a weekly basis, thus can continue to be supported in clinic.

REDUCE OVERCROWDING in MAMI clinics through more frequent provision of facility-based services (e.g. from 1 to 5 days per week) for those needing to attend the clinic.
